

Mini's Show FAQs

Who does hair and makeup? Hair and makeup is required to be done by each individual's parent or caregiver before their child gets to the theatre unless other arrangements have been made. Instructions for this are sent out in term 4.

Can the students watch the show? No, the students are not able to watch the show from inside the theatre. Students will be able to watch all of the dances during their run through beforehand and on backstage screens. The show is filmed, and Students will have all access to both shows, to be able to share them with friends and family easily and to download them too, should you wish to do so.

Where can I purchase tickets? Tickets are available for purchase online from the start of Term 2 at www.eventfinda.co.nz

Do students keep their costumes? No, costumes are the property of Aspire. The costumes will be at the theatre for the students to put on when they arrive for dress rehearsals and show, and are required to be put back in their bag and into their box before leaving. Students must wear their Aspire uniform to and from the theatre for show weekend.

What happens with my child while I watch the show? Students will be looked after by our Aspire staff, assistant teachers and senior students during the Mini's show. This means that no parent help is required and all parents are able to go sit back, relax and watch the show! Your child may be dropped to the dressing rooms at the given arrival time, and then picked up from here also once the show has finished. Details for this will be advised term 4.

Can parents attend the pre-show dress rehearsal? No. Dress rehearsals are closed to all parents. Thank you for your understanding with this.

Does it cost extra to be in the show? Yes. There is a one off \$25 (for minis) show participation cost and a mandatory media fee of \$35 per family which gives all access our filming content of both shows.
